Helpful Hints

Please visit the preschool prior to the first day of care with your child. For children starting in September, there is a Student/Parent/Teacher meeting scheduled for the third week of August. This allows your child to meet the teachers and see their classroom and meet their classmates so when you speak with them about Shining Star Preschool Little Stars, they will be able to relate to what you are saying.

When you drop your child off, release them to the teacher or aide and leave as soon as possible. The longer you stay, the longer the adjustment period. Trust us to call you if the child will not settle in after a reasonable amount of time.

Be sure to sign your child “in” and “out” on the classroom attendance clipboard each day. This is extremely important for emergency situations and liability issues.

Let your child know that they are loved and assure them that you will be back to get them at a time reference they can understand (i.e. after lunch or after nap time etc).

Be consistent once a decision has been made about attending Little Stars or potty training. Then follow through. Children need to know what to expect.
